Key Responsibilities

Asset Maintenance and Inspections:

• Organise and coordinate inspections, maintenance, repairs, and reporting for reservoirs, water pump stations, flushing devices, and disinfection stations.

Water Quality Management:

- Assist in ensuring compliance requirements are met for drinking water/wastewater quality.
- Assist in the development and implementation of applicable Management Plans.
- Contribute to the development and implementation of appropriate risk management practices for water and wastewater treatment systems and operations.
- Participate in the development and modification of Council policies and procedures relating to water quality management.
- Maintain knowledge of Australian Drinking Water Guidelines
- Assist in monitoring, auditing, and reviewing compliance with management plans, water quality sampling programs, and associated processes, contributing to continuous improvement where possible.
- Carry out defined water sampling programs across the water supply network downstream of the Water Treatment Plants.
- Liaise with project teams concerning the commissioning of watermain projects in relation to water quality considerations.
- With the support of the Water and Sewerage team, assist in managing disinfection implementation, including chlorine stations and chlorine additions to the distribution system to maintain safe drinking water, and maintain daily data logging.

Stakeholder Management:

- Respond to enquiries from internal and external customers promptly and professionally.
- Effectively consult with senior staff to set workloads and priorities, report information, and gain assistance with jobs.
- Contribute to the provision of technical advice and support to staff regarding management plans, statutory
 compliance and reporting matters, water/wastewater quality issues, treatment matters, and water quality
 monitoring procedures and equipment.

Reporting and Documentation:

- Assist in the preparation of a range of documents, including technical reports, policies, procedures, work instructions, and action plans.
- Oversee the collection and collation of data for regular and annual reporting functions to ensure timeframes are met.
- Provide support for water quality and sewer incident investigations. This includes:
 - Maintaining internal database records to general Council reports for relevant government stakeholders.
 - $\circ\quad$ Assisting with water quality and sewer incident investigations.

Fundamental Responsibilities

Physical Demands and Work Environment

- Incumbents will encounter occasional exposure to risks in the workplace which will require you to follow relevant site processes and wear the appropriate identified personal protective equipment (PPE) to ensure the safety of all employees.
