#### Barking, Wandering & Unattended Dogs

Council frequently receives complaints regarding barking, wandering and unattended dogs. For the safety of the community and visitors, we ask if you could please keep your dog(s) restrained and attended to. Nuisance dogs may be impoundment by



one of Council's authorised officers may. We ask you to be mindful of all community members and visitors as this behaviour can cause unnecessary dispute.

#### Two dog maximum

As of 19 April 2017, a maximum of two of dogs per household is permitted within the designated town.
