The artwork selected -by a clear margin was No 5 - the original old hospital photo with nurses on the veranda.

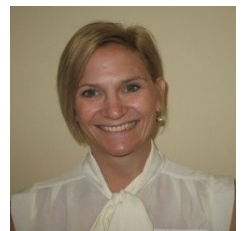
