Drought Assistance Options – Appointments Available

As many in the Barcaldine region continue to hope for much needed rain, financial assistance of up to \$1 million is available to help refinance debt, assisting cash flow and reducing financial burden until things improve. This relief is available through Drought Assistance Concessional Loans delivered by The Queensland Rural and Industry Development Authority (QRIDA) on behalf of the Australian Government. With an interest rate of 3.09% and an interest-only period of up to 5 years, refinancing to this loan can have a big impact.

To chat about your individual situation and how a Drought Assistance Concessional Loan may be able to help, you can catch Regional Area Manager for the Central Highlands and West, Bradley Whittington, in Aramac on Thursday 22 March and in Muttaburra on Friday 23 March. He will also be able to discuss the other assistance QRIDA can offer primary producers, including Farm Management Grants to help you access professional advice on succession planning.
