Drought Assistance Options – Appointments Available

Financial assistance of up to \$1 million dollars is available to help refinance debt, assisting cash flow and reducing financial burden until things improve. This relief is available through Drought Assistance Concessional Loans delivered by The Queensland Rural and Industry Development Authority (QRIDA) on behalf of the Australian Government. With an interest rate of 3.09% and an interest-only period of up to 5 years, refinancing to this loan can have a big impact.

To chat about your individual situation and how a Drought Assistance Concessional Loan may be able to help, you can catch Regional Area Manager for the Central Highlands and West, Bradley Whittington. **Please note the correction - he will visit Aramac from 8.30am to 12noon and Muttaburra from 1pm to 4.30pm on Thursday 22 March 2018.**

He will also be able to discuss the other assistance QRIDA can offer primary producers, including Farm Management Grants to help you access professional advice on succession planning.
