Queensland Dog Breeder Register

Queensland Government has introduced laws to promote responsible breeding of dogs, these laws apply to any dog born on or after 26 May 2017. A person who sells, advertises or gives away a dog, must have a Supply Number. The Supply Number allows the person who bred a dog to be contacted.

Road Safety week

Aramac Police would like to advise all road users that Road Safety Week is being held between Monday 27 August 2018 and Friday 31 August 2018.

During this State-Wide Road Safety initiative Aramac Police will be conducting various activities targeting all road users from pedestrians to heavy vehicles.

Road users detected committing offences will be issued with Infringement Notices and provided education specific to the offence they have committed. It is hoped that this approach will prevent further offences being committed.
