Reminder: Unsightly and Overgrown allotments

Land holders are responsible for keeping their blocks or allotments in a neat and tidy condition that is consistent with the rights and expectation of the local community. This will prevent nuisances from vegetation overgrowth and/or visual pollution resulting from unsightly accumulations of objects and materials.

Examples of objects that may seriously detract from visual amenity of the land:

- Overgrown Vegetation
- Discarded or disused machinery or machinery parts
- Broken-down or severely rusted vehicles
- Discarded bottles, containers and/or packaging
- Refuse or scrap metal
