Watering Times

Council would like to remind all residents of the watering times, which were introduced region wide in September 2013:

Sprinklers, unattended hoses, soaker hoses, drip systems or automatic watering

systems - must not be used between 10am to 3pm daily.

Commercial premises, schools, community clubs or churches can make an application to Council for alteration of watering hours.

Application forms are available from any local Council Administration Office.

Failure to adhere to watering hours will result in a \$130 infringement notice being issued.
